The above organizations are hosting the 17th Annual Sex Crimes Conference to be held December 3-5, 2014. The purpose of this information sharing conference is to bring together federal, state and local law enforcement agencies, Multi-Disciplinary Team (MDT) personnel and SART/SANE personnel to discuss current/emerging trends in high profile special victim cases and child exploitation investigations.

The conference will be held at the Stockton Seaview Hotel and Golf Club, a Dolce Hotel, 401 South New York Road, Galloway Township, New Jersey. There will be an early registration on December 2nd from 4:00 p.m. - 6:00 p.m. Registration will resume at 7:00 a.m. on December 3rd.
