The above organizations are hosting the 18th Annual Sex Crimes Conference to be held December 2-4, 2015. The purpose of this information sharing conference is to bring together federal, state and local law enforcement agencies, Multi-Disciplinary Team (MDT) personnel and SART/SANE personnel to discuss current/emerging trends in high profile special victim cases and child exploitation investigations.

The conference will be held at the Stockton Seaview Hotel and Golf Club, a Dolce Hotel, 401 South New York Road, Galloway Township, New Jersey.
